

First Annual Sheridan-MacKenzie Award

IAABO Board 105 (Vermont) presented the first Sheridan-MacKenzie Award for lifetime contributions to high school basketball to the family of the late Lenny Drew in ceremonies at Montpelier High School recently. Drew, who passed away in 2001, was the long-time basketball coach at Montpelier High, and was a two-time Vermont coach-of-the-year.

The award is named for two legendary Vermont basketball officials and IAABO members, the late Roger Sheridan and Dick MacKenzie. Both Sheridan and MacKenzie are past presidents of IAABO and served the organization in many capacities for decades. MacKenzie, who was on hand to assist in the awards presentation along with several other Board 105 VT members, also served as secretary-treasurer for Board 105 for more than two decades, before stepping down this year.
