

# Verona Spring Meeting 2005



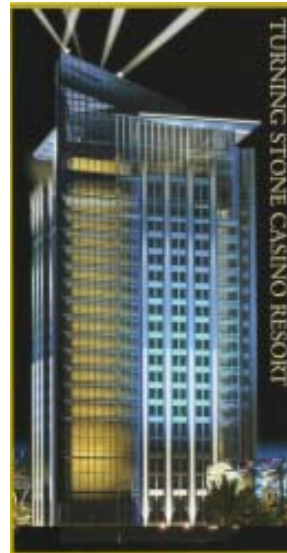
The 2005 Spring Meeting will be held from April 28–May 1 at the Turning Stone Resort and Casino (TSRC) located in Verona, NY. New York Boards No. 38, 51 and 59 will be hosting the event. The TSRC is located off of the New York State Thruway (Interstate 90) approximately 30 miles east of the Syracuse International Airport and 15 miles west of Utica, NY.

In addition to the daily meeting schedule, listed on page 2, several social/recreational events are planned. The first event will be the annual IAABO Spring Golf Outing to be held on Thursday, April 28 at the award winning Shenendoah Golf Club. Shenendoah was designed, constructed, and maintained to tournament standards by course designer Rick Smith.
