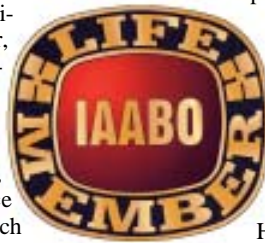

HENRY A. KELLY, JR.

Henry A. Kelly, Jr., 84, of Springfield, MA (Bd. 31 MA) died Sunday, September 14, in Baystate Medical Center, Springfield, MA. Henry was a teacher, assistant principal, and principal for the Springfield Public Schools and retired in 1980. A founding and lifetime member of the Basketball Hall of Fame from 1965 to the time of his death. A basketball official from 1948–98 of Board 31 IAABO, he was honored by them with a 50-year service award and its prestigious lifetime membership, which is the highest honor for an IAABO official. He was



past president of Board 31 IAABO, past president of the Western Massachusetts Junior High School Principals Association, and lifetime member of the Springfield Elks Lodge 61 of Springfield. He served his country with the Army Air Corps during WWII as an Intelligence Investigator. He attained the rank of Staff Sergeant and received the American Theatre Ribbon and the Victory Medal World War II. Henry was known for his devotion to God, family, flag, Notre Dame and the Basketball Hall of Fame.
