## Scorer, Timer, Shotclock, and Pregame Card

The requests from the IAABO Office for the four different instructional cards have been overwhelming. Additional copies of both the high school and collegiate rulebooks are available through the IAABO office. The cost is \$13 for the high school book and \$13 for the college book.

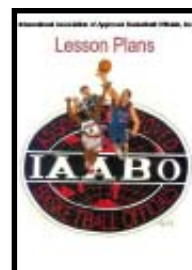


## Refresher Exams
