Bill Received a Master's degree in education from Temple University in Philadelphia, PA in 1963. He was a social studies teacher and coach early in his career before becoming an administrator in 1968. In 1968 he began a long prestigious career as a middle school principal.

actively involved and became affiliated with numerous local, state, and national educational organizations where he served with distinction.
